

- ▶ A visit to Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve & Cape Point (here you will see the endemic Fynbos vegetation (part of a World Heritage Site) along with possible sightings of baboons, bontebok, ostriches, bird life, and Southern Right Whales (seasonal)
- ▶ Lunch will be at Saveur Restaurant in Simonstown.



After your tour, you will be transferred back to your hotel to freshen up in time for dinner. We depart for dinner at 6:15 PM from the hotel lobby.

Beyond is the restaurant at Buitenverwachting, the famed wine farm that means "Beyond Expectation". It originally formed part of the Constantia Estate, which was founded by Simon van der Stel, the first Governor of the new Dutch colony. The restaurant, which affords iconic views over the vineyards, was voted "one of the Top 100 Restaurants" by the American Express Platinum Fine Dining Awards - 2016.

Today, it plays host to the Big 5 and has several game lodges still owned by the same families of the original settlers. The five-star Bush Lodge, your home for the next five nights, has prime positioning overlooking a waterhole and promises superb wildlife viewing opportunities paired with excellent service and world-class dining. Evenings are spent around the outdoor fireplace admiring the unspoiled African starscape.

Each of the lodge's suites have their own secluded viewing deck and plunge pool, while the interior and en-suite bathroom boast a fireplace, oval bath, al fresco double showers and air conditioning. Luxury and privacy await, along with a warm welcome from owners Rod and Tracy Weeks.

A UNIQUE WILDLIFE EXPERIENCE: The itinerary for Amakhala will be flexible because specific animal procedures are only scheduled a week or two in advance (unless there is an emergency procedure).

Over the four full days at Amakhala we plan to do the following:

- ▶ Daily game drives (both sunrise and sunset departure) with either hot drinks and biscuits or sundowners and snacks
- ▶ At least two hands-on animal procedures including helicopter time (please note: we have scheduled at least one rhino procedure, although circumstances such as weather and animal location will dictate the sequencing of the procedures)
- ▶ Hands-on work with game rangers and wildlife veterinarians, including the use of drones, aerial surveillance, tracking, and Amakhala's K9 and equine anti-poaching units
- ▶ A bush walk with game rangers in Amakhala's non-dangerous game area

Your visit to Amakhala will be a truly unique opportunity to go beyond the African safari experience. Over the four days, you will get to experience what it is like to be a wildlife vet, game ranger, and conservationist, but we will also schedule plenty of down time for relaxation and camaraderie.
